What is Youth Advisory Board?

The Volunteer Center of Lubbock Youth Advisory Board program is designed to provide opportunities for young people to become proficient in the ethics and mechanics of board service. Members serve as an advisory board for youth programming at the Volunteer Center. Students are trained in areas of trusteeship, governance, community service, and organizational leadership in order to develop lifelong habits of giving and service.

Who is eligible?

Youth Advisory Board members must be enrolled in grades 9 through 12 and able to attend monthly meetings. Youth Advisory Board members will serve from June to August.
